

The Rubik's Cube and Bible Translation





One day, in October of 2024, my husband came home with a Rubik's Cube to send to our granddaughter. My eyes grew wide, as if to let in a beam of light, so I could see my way back to the Rubik's Cube I once had – the one I never solved and the one I can't remember what happened to it. I held the sealed cube in my hand and studied it to see if there was something different about it this time compared to back then.

There was a different primary color on each of the six sides – white, yellow, green, blue, red and orange – that was the same, just like the one I had. And, like that young girl again, I wanted to open the package and try to solve it. I couldn't help myself as I cut through the plastic to open it. Now in my hand, the cube looking so – new and polished, I started twisting the columns up, down, clockwise, counter-clockwise and then I tried to back track. But, there was no turning back now, the cube was scrambled.

Later that day my husband saw me with it and reminded me we "WERE" going to send the cube to our granddaughter. I told him we could buy another one and send it to her. In the meantime, I was on a quest to solve it. After about a month, I shocked my husband and youngest son as they watched me solve the cube. After that, one of us would scramble the cube and I would solve it. Then, I'd leave the solved cube around the house to find it scrambled. I would sweep it up, solve it, and place it down wherever I was, and again find it scrambled. This went on for months.

One morning after my husband bought three more cubes, two to send to my eldest son and granddaughter


and one for him, I saw our two cubes on a nearby table, side by side. One was solved and the other scrambled. As I was looking at them while drinking my coffee, I began to think of the two cubes in light of Bible translation – for the first time I saw the scrambled one as likened to the church bibles – NIV, KJV, et cetera, and the solved cube as the Keys of the Kingdom Holy Bible.

For months I had been learning about the strict translating laws of grammar, internal harmony, logic, research and text that the Keys of the Kingdom Holy Bible is founded on, and that nothing must transgress those laws.

While studying the KTK bible and comparing it to the church Bibles with these strict translating laws in mind, I kept thinking about the Rubik's Cube, which led me, out of curiosity, on a search about its history.

And ...






The Rubik's Cube in its organically solved appearance is a simple looking cube. Yet, at the same time, it is complex and has deep **roots** that weave their way in and throughout the <u>world of abstraction</u>.

Originally the cube was designed in the 1970s, by Erno Rubik, a 29 year old professor in Hungary, to help teach his students three dimensional geometry and spatial recognition. At the time there were no computers and he needed some kind of <u>logical way of thinking</u> – as <u>logic</u> is part of math, so he sought after some <u>abstract way of thinking</u>, and the cube was a good example.

After he designed the cube and was testing it out, he accidentally scrambled it too much and couldn't get it unscrambled. It took him more than a month researching, facing the problem, trying to understand it, building up theories and testing them. He thought things like: "I have one side and one turn is 90 degrees and if you turn it four times I'll be back where I was," and so on. You have to find rules, he said, and then you find the law of symmetry and the law of movements. It was an emotional experience for him when he figured out how to solve the cube realizing he had beaten a complex challenge to solve it.

Mind boggling is the fact that Rubik's cube has 43 quintillion possible combinations, rendering it nearly inconceivable to solve by chance, yet, just as puzzling, no matter how many twists and turns you take to




Once the cube became a household name and possession, with it came Erno Rubik's analytical question, "how do you find your way between so many possible positions and how can you find your way back?"

In fact many questions have emerged from Rubik's cube and as a result it has become a powerful symbol for problem solving. The cube is a great analogy to critical reasoning or critical thinking as it's all about identifying, analyzing and solving problems systematically. It compels you to question ideas and beliefs and challenge dogma and authority.

Just as significant and for good measure, there is a question to consider usually stemming from cuber's who feel they've reached a dead end presuming the cube is now too scrambled to solve.




The only way to solve the problem, they reason, is to take it apart, reassemble it and start over. Fine. But what would happen if you took the cube apart and reassembled it putting one of the colored pieces into a wrong position?



In retrospect we can take this unsolvable scramble, as it were, as an underlying paradox at play containing hidden truths waiting to reveal errors. It makes us question logical assumptions, forcing us to dig deeper for solutions. It teaches us that anytime we are examining different perspectives in problem solving we must use logic, as logic is the key that unlocks a deeper understanding of truths waiting to be revealed.

Now let's take a look at the Keys of the Kingdom Holy Bible translation, shall we?

ical integrity and is internally harmonious, that is, all free from the chains of "juggling with the text".

Since 1997, much has been restored of the deliberate styles of the divinely-inspired oracles, reproducing phrases according to their grammatical forms and structures; internal harmonies of themes are recovered that have been long concealed in English translations; words and phrases are corrected that have never appeared properly in English; the books are arranged in their proper order, wrong works excluded.

GOD DECLARES HE HATES MIXTURE.

The twelve tribes of the sons of Israel were, by the statutes of God, forbidden from:

- crossbreeding cattle;
- sewing their fields with mixed seed;
- wearing garments mixed of linen and wool (Leviticus $19\19$, $20\12$, Deuteronomy $22\11$);
- forbidden from marrying outside their people, so as not to mix the patriarchal seed (Genesis 28\1, 28\6, Deuteronomy 7\3-4, Joshua 23\12, 1 Kings 8 \53 et cetera).

We should be driven to wanting our translation pure and undefiled, not mixtures of truth and error. We must examine it closely, not blindly accepting the impure mixtures of truth and error, the works of religious orthodoxv.

> Since the King James Bible of 1611 none of those popular translations would translate back into the same Hebrew and Greek meanings of the prophets and apostles.

> For are not all these blunders the very same twisting and perverting and adding and taking away by the "untaught and unstable" that Peter describes in 2 Peter 3\16, ending in men's destruction?

> Have these versions been effective in freeing God's people from the chains of Babylonian mythology and orthodoxy?

> "[R]estrained by reason of state ... conscience forbids juggling with the word of God". However pure our intent, it is a scientific law that pure + impure = impure. "Every tree not producing good fruit gets cut down and is thrown into fire" (Matthew 7\16-19).

> Jesus warned us to beware of the scribes (Mark 12 \38). Their books have been the very sources and poison fountains of post Babylonian mythology and error. It is to these books that men will turn to demonstrate to others those false teachings, who will then pass on the false teachings to others.

"BE DILIGENT TO PRESENT YOURSELF AS APPROVED TO GOD, A WORKMAN NOT ASHAMED, RIGHTLY DIVIDING THE WORD OF TRUTH" (2 TIMOTHY $2\15$).

Those who would oppose The Keys of the Kingdom Holy Bible are likened to those who believe they have scrambled the Rubik's Cube beyond understanding – they do not grasp the laws of LOGIC.

- ♦ It doesn't matter the length of time you scramble;
- ♦ it doesn't matter if you've been at it for years;
- ♦ it can be solved.

The same principle holds true with translating the Bible. If we start with SENSIBLE disciplines, it doesn't matter how much the words are twisted, perverted, added, or taken away – with a persevering spirit, sensibility can be recovered.

The translator's job is to solve the puzzle – to sit down and examine it in detail, applying laws and targets, twisting and turning the symbolic cube, until the "Babel of confusion", as our friend Nicole would say, is at long last restored and makes SENSE once again, as from the beginning.

LOGIC often overlaps with INTERNAL HARMONY. For example Matthew 23\3, in the KJV, 'do' [an imperative verb]; in KTK 'you do put into practice' [an indicative verb]. The effect of the KJV blunder – it uses an imperative verb where context demands an indicative – is that it encourages inappropriate obedience to leaders. The KJV choices are against

all LOGIC and SENSE.

The KJV is wrong at 1 Timothy 6\10 saying money is "the root" of all evils; that is just not true (Genesis 3, for example. Were Adam and Eve after money?), and it is ILLOGICAL. There is no article in the Greek: it should read "a root".

The KJV's BAD LOGIC is a discredit to the word of God.

LOGIC dictates interpretation and understanding so that if, say, God has declared through His prophets that He has set one people apart to be "high above all nations of the Earth" (Exodus 19\5-6, Deuteronomy 7 \6 et cetera), He cannot then also set any other peoples apart into the same high position unless His promise to the first people is broken – which it is not; He made a new and "better Covenant" with the first people (Jeremiah 31\31-31, Matthew 26\26-28, Romans 9\6, Hebrews 7\22, 8\6-13, 9\15, 9\20, 10\16-17, 12\24, 13\20).

The coming Kingdom of the exalted is the "Kingdom of the Heavens" (Matthew 3\2).

By the King James Bible's altering Greek to gentile 7 times it would seem Gods promise has been broken. The Greeks, though, were dispersed Israelites (John 7 \35, 12\20 Ephesians 2\12-14).

THE ABUNDANCE OF THESE ERRATIC VERSIONS IS ALL PART OF THE WARFARE, A MASS PRESERVATION OF MYTH AND ERROR.

Here is a typical general and unquestioning acceptance of the church Bibles from Christianwebsite.com:

"There are approximately 45,000 different Christian denominations worldwide as of 2024. With over 2 billion followers globally, Christianity is the world's largest religion. It's also incredibly diverse, encompassing dozens of denominations with different beliefs, practices, and interpretations of scripture.

"There are twelve main versions of the Bible currently in circulation. They are the King James Version,

The New King James Version, the New International Version, the English Standard Version, the New American Standard Bible, the New Revised Standard Version, the Contemporary English Version, the Good News Translation, The Living Bible, the Holman Christian Standard Bible, The Message, and The Amplified Bible.

"These twelve versions are generally considered to be the most accurate and reliable translations of the Bible available today. While there are many other versions of the Bible in existence, these twelve are considered to be the most authorita-

tive and widely read.

"There are many different versions of the Bible, but <u>all of them contain the same essential message</u>. While there are some minor differences between the various versions, they all agree on <u>the basic story of God's love for humanity and his plan for salvation</u>. Whether you're looking for a specific version of the Bible or just want to explore the different options, <u>you're sure to find one that meets your needs."</u>



WAS ADAM THE SERPENT IN EDEN?

Any and every preacherman will tell you what happened in Eden, right?

I mean, it's all explained in Milton's Paradise Lost. There were Adam and Eve in their Garden of Paradise. Just one tree they're not allowed to eat from. But all the others they can eat from.

Slithering along comes "the Great Satan", a talkin'-crawlin' snake. And, as a talkin'-crawlin' snake, he deceives Eve.

She says we can't eat or even touch the one tree, or we'll die.

Satan says no you won't. You'll be like God.

She eats.

The snake seems to have gone away somewhere.

She gives some to her husband Adam.

The snake comes back to the little gathering, and God rebukes the three of them ... Well!

And that's the GREAT BIG FALL OF ALL MANKIND.

And that's in the Bible, right?

Satan in Eden. Adam and Eve deceived by Satan.

"ADAM WAS NOT DECEIVED". WHAT THE WORD OF GOD IS GOING TO TELL YOU ABOUT IT ...

Only ... only it doesn't say "Satan". Does it? Not once, anywhere does it say anything like "Satan". It says "serpent". Well, everyone just knows it was Satan, don't they? Satan deceived Adam and Eve.

Only it doesn't say "Satan".

And it doesn't say Adam was deceived either.

It says "Adam was not deceived" (1 Timothy 2\14). Oh.

ADAM WAS NOT DECEIVED. Adam wasn't DECEIVED by anybody.

It's a big made-up story that Adam was deceived by anybody.

And the true word of God says,

"Sin came into the world through one man" (Romans 5\12). "One man".

Surely it was two, Satan and Adam?

No, "one man".

And it's "the transgression of Adam" (Romans 5\14).

Not any "Satan" mentioned. Funny that.

But that word saying that "Adam was not deceived" (1 Timothy 2\14)

... wasn't he deceived by Satan? Wasn't Adam deceived by Satan? No.

"ADAM WAS NOT DECEIVED". And it doesn't say "Satan" either.

Adam's sinful "serpent" nature put Eve to the test.

It was Adam who was the slanderer. And the tempter.

"Sin came into the world through one man." Adam.

But, says the "Satan" preacherman, that "one man" sin came into the world through was Satan.

No, Romans 5\12: "one man." ONE.

You can't have two, sorry. It says "one".

It goes straight on to say that that "one man" was Adam: "death reigned from Adam" and "the transgression of Adam, who is a figure of the one soon coming" (Romans 5\13-14).

"Sin came into the world through one man" (Romans 5\12). Adam.

"The transgression of Adam" (Romans 5\14).

It didn't come through anyone called Satan.

Reform Theology ADDED Satan.

Reform Theology PITCHFORKED Satan into the Genesis 3 story,

lying it was someone called "Satan".

Contrary to the written and inspired word of God.

But it does say "serpent". Ha nachash. Hebrew. Snake.

It doesn't say Satan.

And Adam was the "one man". Romans 5\12: "one man". Nobody else responsible.

Say that again in capital letters. NOBODY ELSE WAS RESPONSIBLE. Just Adam.

The "one man" who brought in sin and death in the world.

And that sin was deception.

Deception of Eve. Beguiling her.

For it stands written – and "the Scripture cannot be broken" –

"ADAM WAS NOT DECEIVED."

That's what it says.

And it also stands written, "in Adam all die" (1 Corinthians 15\22). In Adam. Not in anybody called "Satan". For there is nobody in existence called "Satan". All sin and death came through Adam. "In Adam all die." Not Satan.

NOBODY DECEIVED ADAM.

Genesis 3 doesn't even say anybody deceived Adam: only that Eve gave some fruit to him (3\6).

And this is why the judgement is "judgement of the one sin"; and "the offence of the one" (Romans 5\16-17).

There were not two who sinned in Eden, Christendom's "Satan" and Adam. Just one. Adam. And not two sins. Just "one sin" (Romans 5\16).

And this is why the rebellion in Eden is called "one act of transgression" (Romans 5\18). And "the disobedience of one man"; and "the disobedience of one" (Romans 5\19). "The transgression of Adam" (Romans 5\14).

And seeing that there was only one deceiver in Eden, we can understand 2 Corinthians 11\3: "the serpent beguiled Eve". Adam, the serpent.

Not a narrative about a fallen angel against a man and woman in their God-given garden. A human conflict over the first legal commandment of God. One deceiver. One deceived.

The mind is its own place, and in itself can make a heaven of hell, a hell of heaven.



Yevich Romanov is a serious literary work even though it's comedy. There's a glossary at the back of some scarecrow speak, and other languages, and some of Christopher's own invented words.


